

## STUDENT EXCHANGES

The International Veterinary Students' Association (IVSA) - which represents approximately 35,000 veterinary students throughout the world - is actively involved in organising student exchange programmes. Each member faculty or country provides an Exchange Officer (EO) who is responsible for arranging exchanges. This officer sends out forms on behalf of exchange applicants to the EO in the country the student wishes to visit. This EO then identifies an appropriate placement for the student, be it in a university or private practice.

Students seeking placements should contact their IVSA EO for further information and an application form. The national veterinary students' association should be able to identify the local IVSA EO.
