

## **Dr Mark Dagleish – Head of Pathology, Moredun Research Institute**

Mark Dagleish graduated from the Royal (Dick) School of Veterinary Studies in Edinburgh in 1990 and spent over 4 years in practice before returning to the 'Dick' to undertake a PhD on the characterisation of some aspects of the proteinase: antiproteinase balance in the horse with reference to lung disease. Subsequent to this he was awarded a lectureship in animal science at the University of Wales, Aberystwyth in 1998. In June of 2002 he returned to Scotland to take up the position of research pathologist at the Moredun Research Institute.

His main areas of research are lung disease in ruminants and the pathology of wildlife diseases, with special reference to marine mammals. He is a member of the neuropathology surveillance team based at the Moredun Research Institute and is responsible for the histopathology of sea mammals stranded in Scottish coastal waters.
