He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons and holds their Diploma in Sheep Health and Production. He is a Diplomate of the European College of Small Ruminant Health Management. He has been employed by University of Edinburgh, Royal (Dick) School of Veterinary Studies, Large Animal Practice for 12 years, and recently gained a PhD for research into the subject of anthelmintic resistance in sheep nematode parasites.
