

Dr. Peter Jones - Former Executive Director, global International Federation for Animal Health (IFAH)

Peter Jones graduated from the Faculty of Veterinary Science at Liverpool University in July 1971.

After several years in general veterinary practice in the United Kingdom and Ontario, Canada he joined the pharmaceutical industry in the animal health sector and has held a number of senior appointments in research and regulatory affairs in multinational companies, working both in Europe and in the United States, with Elanco Animal Health and MSD Agvet.

He has published reports of his work on antimicrobials and anthelmintics in veterinary medicine, and on critical aspects of registration of veterinary medicinal products. He joined the European Agency for the Evaluation of Medicinal Products in June 1995, and was appointed Head of the Unit for Veterinary Medicines and Inspections in December of the same year.

After ten years at the EMEA Peter Jones was appointed Executive Director of the global International Federation for Animal Health (IFAH) in October 2005, based in Brussels. He now lives in the UK and runs a consultancy in veterinary medicines.
