A microaggression is an intentional or accidental comment or action that negatively targets a marginalised group of people. Here are some common examples which can harm BAME colleagues.

"I don't see colour" :

"No, where are you really from?"

"You act so white" "You speak English so well"

"All lives matter"

"You people..." : "She is so exotic"

"When was the last time you went 'home'?"

Remember to focus on the effect your words and actions can have on others – your **intentions** are not the only thing that matter
