Purpose of role

To support Council to:

- Fulfil its primary role of representing members' views on a wide range of animal health and welfare, public health, and veterinary professional issues.
- Horizon scan for the hot topics of interest to the profession.
- Contribute to the development of policy, lobbying and campaigning priorities for each Association year.

Key responsibilities

- Gathering the views of members in the region and monitoring the allocated email account.
- Ensuring that the views of members in the region are represented at Council meetings
- Maintaining contact with active BVA territorial divisions in the region.
- Contributing to discussions at meetings and via the online workspace.
- Reading papers in advance of meetings.
- Participating in four meetings per year (remote option available)
- Safeguarding and promoting the values of BVA at all times.
- Supporting BVA Young Vet Network activity in the region
- Promoting BVA and BVA membership as appropriate.

Knowledge, skills, and expertise

Members must be MRCVS, hold current BVA membership, and be resident in the region being represented. Across Council we are looking for a mix of experience and expertise, including:

- Committee experience
- Policy development skills and experience
- Strategic thinking
- Evidence gathering and research
- Analysis and evaluation
- Understanding of the current veterinary landscape
- Understanding of political and cultural climate in which BVA seeks to influence policy makers.
